President's 2016 Annual Report

his was the fourth year of the Foundation's Five Year Plan. Annual goals continue to be met thanks to the generosity of all of you who continue to support our students.

For this year, there were 63 teacher grant requests and we were able to fulfill 51 of these with a total value of over \$17,500.

This was an **increase of over 21** % over the previous year. As with the previous year, many of these grants were for technology devices .

We continue to receive ever increasing contributions including support from Corporate Foundations, Memorials and Honorariums, Teachers, and Administrators, Businesses, and Individuals who value education. A complete list of supporters can be found near the end of this report.

Besides your generous contributions, investment earnings continue to provide support towards the Foundation's goals. It is now becoming clear that with your continued support, the 2017 goal of \$20,000 in classroom grants will be met. We will be announcing a new Three Year Plan starting in 2018 that will continue to increase the support of the students. We continue to greatly appreciate your contributing support of the Educational Foundation for our teachers and as always, most importantly, our students. 


Our Watertown Jig Jog Fundraiser Event

Once again, we're gearing up for our Annual Fundraising Event...and there are many ways you can participate!



Teacher Grant Application Process

Teachers in all eligible schools are welcome and encouraged to fill out a Grant Application. Simply go to our web site, fill it out, and mail it in.

Questions will be asked such as description of project, activity or usage, items or material requested, goals and objectives, the intended benefit for the students, estimated cost (\$1,000 maximum request), number of students involved, how long the project will be active, if it's a one-time or continuing project, and if other teachers are involved.

Forms must be submitted by an October deadline designated each year.

The Educational Foundation board members then meet and award as many grants as possible, based on the funds we have available and the needs of our teachers.

We are very pleased to announce that, thanks to the generosity of many, we were able to award 51 grants totaling \$17,500 to teachers in 2016.
